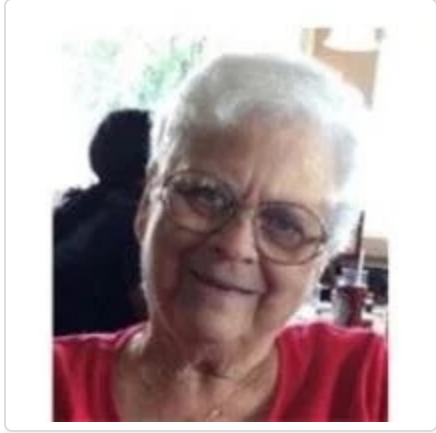




Betty Aronowitz
