Charles Barry Goldberg, of Houston, Texas, passed away on June 18, 2023, at the age of 67. Charles was born in Houston on August 15, 1955, to Morris z”l and Dolly Goldberg and has resided here his entire life. Charles graduated from Stephen F. Austin High School and later The University of Texas at Austin where he met his wife. Charles was in the home healthcare business for many years and founded SleepRestfully, Inc. in 2008. Although he recently relinquished the reins, he remained devoted to his business until his death. Charles loved animals, the outdoors, traveling, coaching soccer, the gym, and most of all his family. Taking after his father, Charles would strike up a conversation with anyone he met, from a clerk at a grocery store to an employee who was beginning his first day at work. Those conversations included lots of laughs and, more often than not, an inappropriate comment or two.

Charles leaves behind his devoted wife of 45 years, Louise Koslin Goldberg, his children Jason Goldberg and wife Megan, Emily Knox and husband Jason, Kevin Goldberg and wife Jacqueline, Alexa Goldberg Janicke and husband Clayton, and his “favorite children,” his dogs—Bella and Maise, and brothers Harold and Daniel Goldberg. Charles also leaves behind his seven wonderful grandchildren who loved him dearly Henry, Jane, Eli, Ezra, Katherine, Sophie, and Abigail. He is also survived by his mother Dolly Goldberg and multiple adored nieces.

Over the past 33 months, Charles taught his family and loved ones the meaning of strength as he battled pancreatic cancer. After his diagnosis, Charles became determined to live life to the fullest and fulfill his bucket list, which included going on a safari in Africa, riding Amtrack cross country, and walking his youngest daughter down the aisle, the last of which he checked off this past Memorial Day Weekend. Charles and his family are grateful for the support of the doctors at MD Anderson, and hope that one day there is a cure for this horrible disease.
