



Charlotte Austin Gaman

February 13, 1936 - October 20, 2022

Charlotte Austin Gaman passed away peacefully on October 20, 2022, after a lengthy illness. She was 86 years old at the time of her death. She was born on February 13, 1936, in Beaumont, Texas, to Henry and Frances Austin.

After graduating from high school in 1954, Charlotte worked for a year as a teacher for the Temple Emanuel religious school before moving to Houston, where she worked as a secretary at the Finger Furniture Company and later for the Prudential Insurance Company. It was in Houston that she met her future husband, Morris Gaman, at a dance at the old Jewish Community Center building. They were married by Rabbi Samuel Rosinger of Temple Emanuel on February 5, 1956. After marriage, she devoted her life to taking care of her family.

Charlotte was preceded in death by her parents; her younger sister, Lynne Austin Holtzman, and her beloved husband of 50 years, Morris Gaman. She is survived by her two sons, Gerry Gaman of Houston, Texas; Alan Gaman and wife Lori Gaman of El Paso, Texas; her two grandsons, Harrison Gaman and Colin Gaman of Crete, Nebraska; and many other family members and friends.

The funeral service for Charlotte was held on Friday, October 21, 2022, at the Congregation Beth Israel Memorial Garden, 1101 Antoine Dr., Houston, Texas
