Edward Andrew Calcote passed away after a hard fought battle with colon cancer on September 3, 2016 at the age of 58.

Ed is predeceased by his mother and father, Jack and Mary Jane Calcote.

Ed is survived by his loving wife, Amy of 34 years. Ed is lovingly remembered by his son Kyle of Orlando, Florida and his daughter Ashleigh of Houston, Texas.

Ed was born in Hot Springs, Arkansas on June 2, 1958. He graduated from Hot Springs High School in 1976 and went on to earn a BS in Chemistry and Math from the University of Arkansas - Woo Pigs Sooi! --in 1981. He worked in the lubricant section of Shell Oil Company for the past 17 years. Ed enjoyed cycling and tennis. He was also a youth bowling coach for 13 years, and was a member of the Texas USBC Youth Committee for 10 years. In July 2006, he was listed in the Bowler's Journal International as an outstanding coach, and in 2015 he was inducted into the Houston Bowling Hall of Honor for recognition of his dedication to youth bowling. Multiple youth in his program received national awards and were awarded bowling scholarships at the college level.

Graveside service will be held at 2:30 pm in Webster at Forest Park East Cemetery on Tuesday, September 6, 2016.
