



## Fay Levine Miller

November 5, 1930 - March 25, 2026

Fay Levine Miller died in Houston, Texas on Wednesday, March 25, 2026. She was the devoted wife of Irwin Miller for 76 years and mother of Marilyn Levin and husband, Alan; Susan Chafitz and the late Barry Chafitz; Russel Miller and wife, Mary; and Patti Solomon and husband, Dean. Fay was the sister of Evelyn Cohen and the late Sammy Levine as well as the daughter of the late Ethel and Issie Levine. She was a grandmother to nine grandchildren and great-grandmother to 15 great-grandchildren.

Fay was born in Houston, Texas and lived her entire life of 95 years there. She attended the University of Texas for one semester. She returned to Houston to be closer to Irwin and completed her first year of college at the University of Houston.

Fay and Irwin were married on October 16, 1949. She left college to raise her family of four. Seventeen years later, Fay returned to the University of Houston and completed her undergraduate degree in Sociology and a master's degree in Social Work. She had a private practice and focused on marriage and family counseling. Fay was a founder of the YES program at Beth Yeshurun Synagogue. She also developed and led bereavement groups at the synagogue. Fay was an accomplished pianist and played piano at MD Anderson Hospital. She was also a docent at the Houston Museum of Fine Arts.
