Frank Seliger, 68, passed away peacefully on Thursday, March 26, 2026, in Austin, Texas.

Frank attended the High School for the Performing and Visual Arts in Houston, Texas, where he studied drama and graduated in 1975. He went on to earn a Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of Texas in 1979.

He began his career as a creative in Houston's advertising community before eventually settling in Austin. There, his path evolved in meaningful ways—teaching junior high school, working as a social worker, and continuing to develop his artistic voice.

Frank had a rare and practical brilliance—an ability to fix just about anything—which led him into a third chapter of buying, restoring, and recycling appliances back into the Austin community. He found purpose in giving things—and often people—another life.

He loved fostering cats and had a natural gift with plants, a talent passed down from his father, Maurice Seliger.

Frank is survived by his mother, Carol Lee; his brothers, Yoel and Mark; and his sister, Lori.
