September 29, 1944 - August 16, 2021

Herman "Hermie" Litt, 76, passed away peacefully on Monday night, August 16, 2021, after a long and difficult illness, with his beloved wife Marilyn at his side. Herman was born on September 29, 1944 in Houston, Texas to the late Gaston and Jennie Litt. Herman graduated from San Jacinto High School in 1962 and was later president of its alumni association, and he spent his high school years as a proud member of AZA 136. He graduated from the University of Houston, where he met Marilyn, and they married in 1967. Herman was a psychotherapist and rehabilitation counselor who worked with a variety of different populations over the course of his career, including the physically and mentally disabled and people suffering from addiction. Herman had a lifelong interest in politics and became politically active later in life, serving as a member and ultimately chairman of the Houston Community College Board of Trustees and active in many community organizations and local Democratic clubs. He also loved sports, and was known as "Coach Litt" by the many kids he coached on his children's teams over the years. Herman was preceded in death by his parents and his daughter Risa. He is survived in death by his wife Marilyn, his son Greg and his wife Elana, his beautiful grandchildren Nava, Eden and Gabriel, and his brother Maurice, along with many other loving friends and family. A graveside service was held on Wednesday, August 18, 2021 at 11:00AM at Beth Yeshurun Post Oak, 1037 Post Oak Rd, Houston, TX 77055.
