



## Isaak Samuilovich Rubinstein

January 1, 1935 - August 3, 2021

Isaak Samuilovich Rubinstein passed away on Tuesday, August 3, 2021. He was born January 1, 1935, in Berdichev, Ukraine, and fled the Nazis with his mother at the age of 6 while his father perished in the Holocaust. He grew up in the Ural mountains and eventually moved to Moscow where he obtained an Engineering degree. He fell in love and married Marina and they lived in Russia until moving to Houston in 2004. Isaak will be remembered for his positivity and determination. Despite several bouts of cancer, diabetes, heart issues and a stroke over the years he cooked nutritious food for himself and walked several miles a day until a couple of weeks ago. He adored his grandchildren who will forever be Earl Grey tea drinkers thanks to nightly tea time with their grandfather. Isaak is survived by his children, Leon Rubinstein & Allie Falender and Alexander & Vera Rubinstein; and his 5 grandsons, Elijah, Micah, Samuel, Yakov and Gregory.
