Jenet "Jenny" Fay Segall passed away on March 15th, 2018 surrounded by her family and loved ones. Born in Johannesburg, South Africa, she was a journalism graduate from the University of Witwatersrand. She was an active member of the Jewish community in South Africa where she met her husband, Chaim Segall. Their story began at a Jewish community function in South Africa and would grow to last a lifetime as they stayed active running Jewish functions and camps all over the country. Their work had a profound impact on hundreds of kids spanning more than four decades. Jenny worked as a journalist for the Jewish Herald in South Africa for thirty years before immigrating with her husband to the United States in 1998. She continued working in the Jewish community as soon as she arrived, working for Chabad Outreach of Houston over the past twenty years.

Jenny is survived by her husband, Chaim Segall to whom she recently celebrated their sixtieth wedding anniversary. She is also survived by her son Ivor, daughter Marna, son-in-law Steven, daughter-in-law Angie, grandchildren Ayli, Roy, Darren, Joshua and Alex, and great grandson, Noam.
