



Maurice Robinowitz

Maurice (Rock) Robinowitz, 91, passed away on December 11 at home. He was a native of Houston, graduated from Lamar High School in 1944 and from Texas A&M, Class of '48. He served in the Army Air Corps in the Pacific Theater.

Rock was known for his dry, witty sense of humor; his embrace of people from all walks of life; and his love of Texas A&M.

He was a president of Houston A&M Club and served as class agent for Class '48. In 1991, he retired from the grocery business, and began a new chapter of his life, volunteering.
