



## Myron Gerald MD

July 26, 1929 - May 16, 2019

Myron Gerald Fine, MD age 89, of Dallas, Texas, passed away May 16, 2019. He was born in Newport News, Virginia on July 26, 1929 to Marjorie Vivien Samuelson and Lawrence Stanley Fine. Dr. Fine graduated from University of Tennessee Medical School at age 22 and interned at Sinai Hospital in Baltimore, MD. After his internship, he was called to serve as an army surgeon in the Korean War, attaining the rank of Captain. Following the war, he met his wife of 62 years, Brooke Bernice Rash Fine, in New Orleans, LA while completing his Urology Residency at Tulane University's Charity Hospital. In 1958, he moved to Dallas, TX, becoming the fourth generation of his family to live in Texas, and joined Baylor Hospital. There he served as Head of the Urology Department for many years and took pride and patience in helping to train residents at Parkland Hospital as a Clinical Professor. For over 50 years he maintained a urology practice in Dallas and was joined by his son, urologist Dr. Joshua Fine, for 20 of these years. In his spare time, Dr. Fine loved to travel and enjoyed good food, beautiful gardens and museums across almost every continent. On Sundays, you could find him with his friends on the tennis courts at Churchill Park. In addition to his beloved wife, Dr. Fine is survived by his children Aimee Fine Adashek (Dr. Steven Adashek), Lawrence Fine, and Dr. Joshua Kory Fine (Dr. Chitra Jayaseelan Fine); his sister Ann (Fine) Smith; his grandchildren Dr. Michael Adashek (Dr. Nicole Larkin), Jonathan Fine, David Adashek, Samantha Fine, Emily Fine; and honorary grandchildren Hannah D'Apice, Rachel D'Apice, Lizzy D'Apice,
