



Nancy Gordon Coben

Nancy Gordon Coben died peacefully on Tuesday, August 27 at her home in Houston.

Nancy and Lew married in 1953, settling in Cleveland and owning a Barton's Candy store that served the community until the Cobens moved to Dallas in 1970. After retiring from working alongside Lew for many years, Nancy became the registrar at the religious school at Temple Emanu El in Dallas, where she

loved being enveloped in her Judaism on a daily basis and interacting with families.

Moving to Houston to be near their grandchildren, Nancy volunteered for Ellen Cohen's first campaign and became a regular volunteer at Texas Children's Hospital. She remained active at Brookdale, registering voters for each election and staying up to date on political events.

Services were held at Congregation Emanu El Houston, Nancy has been laid to rest in Dallas next to her husband and grandson.
