



Phillip Herman Feldman

April 7, 1941 - March 25, 2025

It is with great sadness that we announce the death of Phillip (Pop) Herman Feldman, who passed away peacefully on Tuesday, March 25, 2025, at the age of 83.

He is survived by his son, Chad Feldman and wife Heather (Beaumont); Granddaughter, Mallory Leasure, her husband Bryce and great grandson Beau (Cypress) and grandson, Judd Ross (Lumberton); his sister, Ruthie Davis (Houston) and numerous nieces, nephews, their children and many friends.

Phillip was predeceased by his parents, Max and Bessie Feldman; his brothers, Arthur Feldman, Paul Feldman, Jerome Feldman, Abe Feldman and Louis Feldman; and his sister Marie Cweren.

Phillip was born on April 7, 1941, to Max and Bessie Feldman in Beaumont, Texas. He was the seventh out of the eight Feldman children. He graduated from Beaumont High, attended Lamar University and served in the United States Air Force.

Upon returning from service, he became the ultimate salesman we all know and loved at Feldman Furniture and numerous other places.

Growing up in a large family, he loved spending time with his siblings and their children in Houston through the years. He would always stir up trouble with his siblings with a twinkle in his eye and a big smile. He loved his family.

Pop himself stated his life can be divided into two parts – life before his one and only son Chad was born and the best life after Chad was born. He was Chad's biggest fan. He introduced Chad, to great music, designer clothing, Rolex watches and incredible food. He also taught Chad the art of negotiating – because everything is negotiable.

Chad's childhood friends to this day talk about Phillip "Philco" the man, the myth, the legend and all the fun times they had growing up and going to the big city.

He was proud of his son's business - Feldman Fitness and made sure he advertised it with hats, shirts and his trusty windbreaker. He handed out business cards of Chad's and if you didn't know who his son was, he made sure that you knew who he was before you left.

He officially earned the name Pop when his granddaughter Mallory was born. He loved every aspect of being a grandfather – her Pop. They spent every other weekend riding the roads between Houston and Beaumont. They would sing songs, and he would tell stories about people he knew at certain places they would pass by. Most importantly, they would discuss what they were going to eat at Gator Junction.

In 2010, Heather and her young son, Judd joined the family. Judd and Pop spent many days after school and weekends going to every pet store in town and looking for great deals on burgers and knick knacks. His Pop's charisma resulted in many people throughout his life adopting him as their own grandfather. He was truly loved by many.

Pop had a list of people he would call daily to check on them. He would usually end his calls with that's how it goes in the big city, have a good day – bye bye. He loved talking on the phone and if you made his call list – that was gold. We will miss his calls, his sense of humor and his special way with words. He was truly the best!
