Phyllis Silver Steinberg, beloved wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother, passed away on Thursday, November 13, 2025, at Eagle's Trace in Houston, Texas. Born in 1929 in Fall River, Massachusetts, she was the only child of Bertha and Leo Silver. After they moved to Parkchester, in the Bronx, Phyllis graduated from Hunter College in New York City in 1950 and went on to receive a Master's Degree in English from Montclair State University.
