Ruth D. Brown, born February 27, 1925 in Dusseldorf Germany, was quietly called home to her heavenly rest Sunday, January 2, 2022. She grew up in Dusseldorf Germany, Barcelona Spain, Switzerland, and Washington D.C., and then lived out her adult life in Texas in Houston, Alief, and Quail Valley in Missouri City, TX.
