



## Samuel Z. Schagrin

June 11, 1950 - December 31, 2024

Samuel Z. Schagrin, 74, passed away suddenly on Tuesday, December 31, 2024, in Phoenix, Arizona.

Sam was born on June 11, 1950, in Walbrzych, Poland. He immigrated to Louisville, Kentucky in 1972 and established himself as a dental technician. After living in Boston, Massachusetts for several years, he eventually settled in Houston in 1977.

He became a U.S. citizen in 1974, and always had a talent for business, including a dental lab and an Ebay store, and specialized in buying, selling, and renting real estate.

Sam is survived by his loving wife of 47 years, Patricia Schagrin.

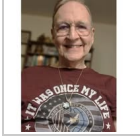
