Shirley Goodman Fish, 87, of Houston, Texas, formerly of Sioux City, passed away peacefully in her home on Tuesday, March 20, 2018 surrounded by her family and loved ones. Services will be held at 2 p.m. on Friday, March 23 at Emanu El Memorial Park, 8341 Bissonnet St. in Houston.

Shirley was born and raised in Chicago, Illinois where she met and fell in love with her husband, Laurence Fish, who was visiting from Sioux City, Iowa.
