



Winnie Lipman

Winnie Faye (Wasserman) Lipman, 91, died Friday, June 17, 2016 at Kindred Hospital.

She was preceded by her beloved husband of 47 years, Morris H. "Moe" Lipman.

She is survived by her daughter, Charlotte Keren and her husband, Joseph Keren; her son, Mark Lipman and his wife, Kathy Lipman; five grandchildren; five great-grandchildren; and many other family members and friends.

Born and raised in Houston as the firstborn daughter of Gershon and Sophie (Moore) Wasserman, Winnie Lipman will always be remembered as a devoted wife, mother, sister, family member and friend.

In her early years, Winnie often helped-out in the family's grocery store. With all of the cookies, candies, and sodas stocked on shelves and readily available, she and her three siblings were often accused of eating-up all of the business' profits.

Winnie graduated from Jefferson Davis High School in 1942. There she proved herself to be a talented musician. She played oboe in the band, sang in the choir and played piano at home. Although Winnie had aspirations to study piano at the Julliard School of Music, faced with the educational norms for women during that time, she decided to forego college. Shortly thereafter,

she met and married the love of her life, Morris H. "Moe" Lipman on February 14, 1943.

In addition to modeling for Foley Brother's Department Stores, Winnie worked for Houston's last City Manager before the city transitioned to a Mayoral system of government. After working in the corporate world for many years, Winnie began her final and most favorite career as a housewife and mother. In this position she raised her two children - daughter Charlotte, and son, Mark.

Winnie was a member of Houston's United Orthodox Synagogue for many years. In addition to keeping a kosher and observing all Jewish holidays and traditions in her home, she proved herself as a leader in Houston's Jewish community by being president of both Mizrahi Women's Organization and Amit Women.
